TASTING NOTES

Located just off the coastal region of Mendocino County, peaceful and bucolic Anderson Valley has warm, sunny days and cool, foggy mornings and nights that create the ideal microclimate for producing our Lazy Creek Vineyards Red Table Wine. A non-vintage, 100% Pinot Noir, this sustainably-farmed Red Table Wine has aromas of raspberry and ripe cherry with lilac and rose floral notes, followed by delicious flavors of dried strawberry, earth and toasted oak.

WINEMAKER NOTES

This wine utilizes only organic materials in the vineyards. The grapes from the low-yielding vineyard are hand harvested, fermented in macrobins – partially whole-cluster fermented – and carefully basket pressed. Aged in new and older French oak, the wine completes malolactic fermentation in barrel before bottling.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Our Lazy Creek Vineyards Red Table Wine is delicious paired with braised meats, fowl, veal, salmon, lobster, prawns, and dishes with creamy sauces and spicy seasonings. Medium-textured soups and stews also pair nicely.
